## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for the utilization of headlights
- during certain periods of rain or snow.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 4302 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 4302. Period for requiring lighted lamps.
- 9 Every vehicle upon a highway at any time between sunset and
- 10 sunrise, during any period of rain or snow when windshield
- 11 wipers are used and at any other time when, due to insufficient
- 12 light or unfavorable atmospheric conditions, persons and
- 13 vehicles on the highway are not clearly discernible from a
- 14 distance of 1000 feet ahead shall display lighted head and other
- 15 lamps and illuminating devices as required under this chapter
- 16 for different classes of vehicles, subject to exceptions with
- 17 respect to parked vehicles. Stop lights, turn signals and other
- 18 signaling devices shall be lighted as prescribed in this title.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
