16	Section 1. Section 654 of the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682,
17	No.284), known as The Insurance Company Law of 1921, is amended

19	Section 654. Classification of Risks; Underwriting Rules;
20	Premium Rates; and Schedule and Merit Rating Plans* * *
21	(a.1) Every rating bureau which establishes any risk
22	classification system, underwriting rule, premium rate, or
23	schedule or merit rating plan for window washing firm employers

- shall establish two separate plans based on the length of time a 1
- 2 firm is engaged in the window washing business over or under ten
- 3 years and the number of employes employed by the window washing
- 4 firm over or under ten employes.
