- 5 WHEREAS, It is evident that the procurement of general
- 6 liability insurance in this Commonwealth in many fields of
- 7 endeavor and, in some areas of this Commonwealth, automobile
- 8 insurance, is becoming increasingly difficult due to severely
- 9 limited availability; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The cost of such insurance that is still available
- 11 is increasing at an alarming rate and, in many instances, is
- 12 prohibitive; and
- WHEREAS, It is imperative that affordable general liability
- 14 insurance and automobile insurance be made readily available to
- 15 the citizens and businesses of this Commonwealth to ensure
- 16 continued economic growth and protection for the citizens;
- 17 therefore be it
- 18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives direct the House

- 1 Insurance Committee to conduct an in-depth investigation into
- 2 the availability and cost of general liability insurance and
- 3 automobile insurance in this Commonwealth; and be it further
- 4 RESOLVED, That the committee may hold hearings, take
- 5 testimony and make its investigations at such places as it deems
- 6 necessary in this Commonwealth. Each member of the committee
- 7 shall have power to administer oaths and affirmations to
- 8 witnesses appearing before the committee; and be it further
- 9 RESOLVED, That the committee report its findings and its
- 10 recommendations for any necessary remedial legislation to the
- 11 House of Representatives as soon as possible.
