AN ACT

1 Amending the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), entitled
2 "An act providing for a State Lottery and administration
3 thereof; authorizing the creation of a State Lottery
4 Commission; prescribing its powers and duties; disposition of
5 funds; violations and penalties therefor; exemption of prizes
6 from State and local taxation and making an appropriation,"
7 FURTHER PROVIDING FOR THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE DEPARTMENT <—
8 OF REVENUE; prohibiting the awarding of certain prizes; AND <—
9 PROVIDING FOR THE PRINTING OF LOTTERY TICKETS OR SHARES.

10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
11 hereby enacts as follows:

12 SECTION 1. SECTION 6(A)(8) OF THE ACT OF AUGUST 26, 1971 <—
13 (P.L.351, NO.91), KNOWN AS THE STATE LOTTERY LAW, IS AMENDED TO
14 READ:

15 SECTION 6. POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE SECRETARY OF REVENUE.--

16 (A) IN ADDITION TO THE POWERS AND DUTIES PROVIDED BY LAW AND

17 "THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF 1929," THE SECRETARY OF REVENUE

18 SHALL HAVE THE POWER AND IT SHALL BE HIS DUTY TO OPERATE AND

19 ADMINISTER THE LOTTERY, AND TO PROMULGATE RULES AND REGULATIONS

20 GOVERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION THEREOF, INCLUDING BUT

1 NOT LIMITED TO:

3 (8) THE METHOD TO BE USED IN SELLING TICKETS OR SHARES AND
4 IN PROMOTING TICKETS AND SHARES: PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT ALL
5 CONTRACTS ENTERED INTO BY THE SECRETARY FOR THE PROMOTION OF
6 TICKETS OR SHARES SHALL BE WITH INDIVIDUALS OR ENTITIES WHICH
7 HAVE THEIR PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS IN THIS COMMONWEALTH.

9 Section ~~1~~ 2. The act of ~~August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91),~~ <—
10 ~~known as the State Lottery Law,~~ is amended by adding a section <—
11 SECTIONS to read: <—

12 Section 10.1. Award of Certain Prizes Prohibited.--(a) No
13 prize shall be awarded unless it shall have been produced or
14 manufactured within the United States, inclusive of all
15 territory, continental or insular, subject to the jurisdiction
16 of the United States. In acquiring prizes for distribution
17 pursuant to this act, the secretary shall, whenever feasible,
18 give priority consideration to products manufactured in
19 Pennsylvania.

20 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a), a
21 motor vehicle may be awarded as a prize if it can be purchased,
22 leased or rented by a public agency because the conditions of
23 section 5(a) of the act of April 4, 1984 (P.L.193, No.40), known
24 as the "Motor Vehicle Procurement Act," are met.

25 SECTION 10.2. PRINTING OF LOTTERY TICKETS OR SHARES.--ALL <—
26 SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE PRINTING OF LOTTERY TICKETS OR SHARES
27 SHALL REQUIRE, AND ALL BIDS RECEIVED IN RESPONSE THERETO SHALL
28 STIPULATE, THAT SUCH LOTTERY TICKETS OR SHARES MUST BE PRINTED
29 WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA.

30 Section ~~2~~ 3. This act shall take effect immediately. <—
