## AN ACT

Amending the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), entitled "An act providing for a State Lottery and administration 3 thereof; authorizing the creation of a State Lottery Commission; prescribing its powers and duties; disposition of 4 5 funds; violations and penalties therefor; exemption of prizes from State and local taxation and making an appropriation," 7 FURTHER PROVIDING FOR THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE; prohibiting the awarding of certain prizes; AND PROVIDING FOR THE PRINTING OF LOTTERY TICKETS OR SHARES. 9 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 hereby enacts as follows: 12 SECTION 1. SECTION 6(A)(8) OF THE ACT OF AUGUST 26, 1971 13 (P.L.351, NO.91), KNOWN AS THE STATE LOTTERY LAW, IS AMENDED TO 14 READ: 15 SECTION 6. POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE SECRETARY OF REVENUE. --16 IN ADDITION TO THE POWERS AND DUTIES PROVIDED BY LAW AND 17 "THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF 1929," THE SECRETARY OF REVENUE SHALL HAVE THE POWER AND IT SHALL BE HIS DUTY TO OPERATE AND 18 ADMINISTER THE LOTTERY, AND TO PROMULGATE RULES AND REGULATIONS

GOVERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION THEREOF, INCLUDING BUT

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- 11 SECTIONS to read:
- 12 Section 10.1. Award of Certain Prizes Prohibited. -- (a) No
- 13 prize shall be awarded unless it shall have been produced or
- 14 manufactured within the United States, inclusive of all
- 15 <u>territory</u>, <u>continental or insular</u>, <u>subject to the jurisdiction</u>
- 16 of the United States. In acquiring prizes for distribution
- 17 pursuant to this act, the secretary shall, whenever feasible,
- 18 give priority consideration to products manufactured in
- 19 Pennsylvania.
- 20 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a), a
- 21 motor vehicle may be awarded as a prize if it can be purchased,
- 22 <u>leased or rented by a public agency because the conditions of</u>
- 23 section 5(a) of the act of April 4, 1984 (P.L.193, No.40), known
- 24 <u>as the "Motor Vehicle Procurement Act," are met.</u>
- 25 SECTION 10.2. PRINTING OF LOTTERY TICKETS OR SHARES.--ALL
- 26 SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE PRINTING OF LOTTERY TICKETS OR SHARES
- 27 SHALL REQUIRE, AND ALL BIDS RECEIVED IN RESPONSE THERETO SHALL
- 28 STIPULATE, THAT SUCH LOTTERY TICKETS OR SHARES MUST BE PRINTED
- 29 <u>WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA.</u>
- 30 Section  $\frac{2}{3}$ . This act shall take effect immediately.
