A SUPPLEMENT

- To the act of (P.L. , No.), entitled "An act 2 providing for the capital budget for the fiscal year 1987-3 1988," itemizing public improvement projects to be constructed or acquired or assisted by the Department of General Services, together with their estimated financial 5 costs; authorizing the incurring of debt without the approval 7 of the electors for the purpose of financing the projects to be constructed or acquired or assisted by the Department of 8 9 General Services; stating the estimated useful life of the projects; and making appropriations. 10
- 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 12 hereby enacts as follows:
- 13 Section 1. Short title.
- 14 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Capital
- 15 Budget Project Itemization Act for 1987-1988.
- 16 Section 2. Total authorizations.
- 17 The total authorization for the additional capital projects
- 18 in the category of public improvement projects itemized in
- 19 section 3 and to be acquired or constructed by the Department of
- 20 General Services, its successors or assigns, and to be financed
- 21 by the incurring of debt, shall be \$500,000.

- 1 Section 3. Itemization of public improvement projects.
- 2 Additional capital projects in the category of public
- 3 improvement projects to be constructed or acquired by the
- 4 Department of General Services, its successors or assigns, and
- 5 to be financed by the incurring of debt, are hereby itemized,
- 6 together with their respective estimated financial costs, as
- 7 follows:
- 8 Total
- 9 Project
- 10 Project Allocation
- 11 (1) Historical and Museum Commission \$500,000
- 12 (i) Somerset Historical Center
- 13 (A) For construction of an addition to the
- 14 center and improvements for parking and
- entrance areas 500,000
- 16 (Base Project Allocation \$425,000)
- 17 (Design and Contingencies \$75,000)
- 18 Section 4. Debt authorization.
- 19 The Governor, Auditor General and State Treasurer are hereby
- 20 authorized and directed to borrow, from time to time, in
- 21 addition to any authorization heretofore or hereafter enacted,
- 22 on the credit of the Commonwealth, subject to the limitations
- 23 provided in the current capital budget, money not exceeding in
- 24 the aggregate the sum of \$500,000 as may be found necessary to
- 25 carry out the acquisition and construction of the public
- 26 improvement projects specifically itemized in a capital budget.

- 28 Section 5. Issue of bonds.
- The indebtedness authorized in this act shall be incurred,
- 30 from time to time, and shall be evidenced by one or more series

- 1 of general obligation bonds of the Commonwealth in such
- 2 aggregate principal amount for each series as the Governor,
- 3 Auditor General and State Treasurer shall determine, but the
- 4 latest stated maturity date shall not exceed the estimated
- 5 useful life of the projects being financed as stated in section
- 6 6.
- 7 Section 6. Estimated useful life and term of debt.
- 8 (a) Estimated useful life.--The General Assembly states that
- 9 the estimated useful life of the public improvement projects
- 10 itemized in this act is as follows:
- 11 (1) Public improvement projects:
- 12 (i) Forest service roads, 10 years.
- 13 (ii) All other projects, 30 years.
- 14 (b) Term of debt.--The maximum term of the debt authorized
- 15 to be incurred under this act is 30 years.
- 16 Section 7. Appropriations.
- 17 The net proceeds of the sale of the obligations authorized in
- 18 this act are hereby appropriated from the Capital Facilities
- 19 Fund to the Department of General Services in the maximum amount
- 20 of \$500,000 to be used by it exclusively to defray the financial
- 21 cost of the public improvement projects specifically itemized in
- 22 a capital budget. After reserving or paying the expenses of the
- 23 sale of the obligation, the State Treasurer shall pay to the
- 24 Department of General Services the moneys as required and
- 25 certified by it to be legally due and payable.
- 26 Section 8. Federal funds.
- 27 In addition to those funds appropriated in section 7, all
- 28 moneys received from the Federal Government for the projects
- 29 specifically itemized in this act are also hereby appropriated
- 30 for those projects.

- 1 Section 9. Effective date.
- 2 This act shall take effect immediately.
