AN ACT

1 2	Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), entitled "An act concerning townships of the second class; and amending,
3 4	revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," further providing for ordinances.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Clause LXII of section 702 of the act of May 1,
8	1933 (P.L.103, No.69), known as The Second Class Township Code,
9	reenacted and amended July 10, 1947 (P.L.1481, No.567) and added
10	August 27, 1963 (P.L.1280, No.521), is amended to read:
11	Section 702. Supervisors to Exercise PowersThe corporate
12	powers of townships of the second class shall be exercised by
13	the township supervisors. Where no specific authority is given
14	for the expenditures incident to the exercise of any power
15	hereinafter conferred, or where no specific fund is designated
16	from which such expenditures shall be made, appropriations for
17	such expenditures shall be made only from the general township
18	fund. In addition to the duties imposed upon them by section 516

1 hereof, they shall have power--

3 LXII. General Powers.--To make and adopt all such 4 ordinances, by-laws, rules and regulations not inconsistent with 5 or restrained by the Constitution and laws of this Commonwealth as may be deemed expedient or necessary for the proper 6 management, care and control of the township and its finances 7 8 and the maintenance of peace, good government and welfare of the township and its trade, commerce and manufactures. [No 9 10 ordinance, by-law, rule or regulation shall be adopted which in any manner restricts, interferes with, hinders or affects the 11 12 operation of any other political subdivision or instrumentality 13 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.]
