AN ACT

1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, imposing a mandatory
3 sentence for persons convicted of bribery in official and
4 political matters.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

9 § 9719. Sentences for offenses involving bribery in official
10 and political matters.

11 (a) Mandatory sentence.--A person convicted of an offense of
12 bribery as prohibited by 18 Pa.C.S. § 4701 (relating to bribery
13 in official and political matters) shall be sentenced to a
14 mandatory term of imprisonment of not less than three years.

15 (b) Eligibility for parole.--Parole shall not be granted
16 until the minimum term of imprisonment has been served.

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
