## AN ACT

- Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
  Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, imposing a mandatory
  sentence for persons convicted of bribery in official and
  political matters.

  The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
  hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 9719. Sentences for offenses involving bribery in official
- 10 and political matters.
- 11 (a) Mandatory sentence. -- A person convicted of an offense of
- 12 bribery as prohibited by 18 Pa.C.S. § 4701 (relating to bribery
- 13 in official and political matters) shall be sentenced to a
- 14 mandatory term of imprisonment of not less than three years.
- 15 (b) Eliqibility for parole.--Parole shall not be granted
- 16 until the minimum term of imprisonment has been served.
- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
