AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, defining offenses relating to unlawful
- 3 use of alcohol or drugs by public transportation workers.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding sections to read:
- 8 § 6911. Unlawful use of alcohol or drugs by public
- 9 transportation worker.
- 10 (a) Offense defined. -- It shall be unlawful for any person
- 11 employed by a public transportation company and engaged in the
- 12 operation of transportation facilities to use, consume or
- 13 otherwise be under the influence of alcohol, or a controlled
- 14 substance as defined in the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233,
- 15 No.64), known as The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and
- 16 Cosmetic Act.
- 17 (b) Prima facie evidence.--It shall be prima facie evidence

- 1 of a violation of this section if, following an accident
- 2 <u>involving transportation facilities</u>, a person tests as follows:
- 3 (1) the amount of alcohol, by weight, in the blood of
- 4 <u>the person tested is 0.10% or more; or</u>
- 5 (2) the person tests positive for the presence of a
- 6 controlled substance in the blood.
- 7 (c) Grading. -- A violation of this section is a felony of the
- 8 third degree.
- 9 (d) Definition.--As used in this section the term "public"
- 10 <u>transportation company" means any private company or public</u>
- 11 agency or authority which operates a bus line, passenger
- 12 railroad line, trolly line or airline for the general public.
- 13 § 6912. Homicide on public transportation.
- 14 (a) Offense defined. -- Any person who unintentionally causes
- 15 the death of another person as the direct result of a violation
- 16 of section 6911 (relating to unlawful use of alcohol or drugs by
- 17 public transportation worker) and who is convicted of violating
- 18 section 6911 is quilty of a felony of the second degree when the
- 19 violation is the cause of death, and the sentencing court shall
- 20 order the person to serve a minimum term of imprisonment of not
- 21 <u>less than three years.</u>
- 22 (b) Applicability of sentencing guidelines. -- The sentencing
- 23 quidelines promulgated by the Pennsylvania Commission on
- 24 <u>Sentencing shall not supersede the mandatory penalty of this</u>
- 25 section.
- 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
