AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, granting civil immunity
- 3 to drivers of emergency vehicles; and making repeals.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 8338. Civil immunity for drivers of emergency vehicles.
- 9 A driver of an emergency vehicle that is being operated
- 10 consistent with the provisions of 75 Pa.C.S. § 3105 (relating to
- 11 drivers of emergency vehicles) shall not be liable for any civil
- 12 damages as a result of any acts or omissions arising out of the
- 13 operation of the emergency vehicle, except any acts or omissions
- 14 <u>intentionally designed to harm or any grossly negligent acts or</u>
- 15 omissions.
- 16 Section 2. 42 Pa.C.S. §§ 8522 (relating to exceptions to

- 1 sovereign immunity) and 8542 (relating to exceptions to
- 2 governmental immunity) are repealed insofar as they are
- 3 inconsistent with this act.
- Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 4
