## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 30 (Fish) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
  - Statutes, further providing for the registration of
- 3 motorboats.

- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 5308 of Title 30 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 5308. Period of registration.
- 9 [Registrations issued under this chapter to owners and
- 10 dealers shall be valid from April 1 of one year to March 31 of
- 11 the succeeding year and shall be renewable. A registration for
- 12 any year shall be valid and may properly be displayed prior to
- 13 April 1 within that year.]
- 14 (a) Staggered renewal system to be established. -- The
- 15 commission shall establish a system of staggered registration
- 16 renewal for owners and dealers so that an approximately equal

- 1 <u>number of registrations will expire every month throughout the</u>
- 2 year. In order to implement and maintain the staggered
- 3 registration system, the commission may prorate annual
- 4 registration fees over registration periods of from 6 to 18
- 5 months.
- 6 (b) New registration. -- A new certificate of registration is
- 7 <u>effective on the date of issuance of a certificate of</u>
- 8 registration by the department.
- 9 <u>(c) Expiration of registration.--A certificate of</u>
- 10 registration shall expire on the last day of the month
- 11 <u>designated on the certificate of registration</u>.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
