## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for restrictions on alcoholic
- 3 beverages.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3715 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 3715. Restriction on alcoholic beverages.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- It is unlawful for any person who is a
- 10 driver in any vehicle to consume any alcoholic beverage or
- 11 controlled substance, as defined in the act of April 14, 1972
- 12 (P.L.233, No.64), known as ["] The Controlled Substance, Drug,
- 13 Device and Cosmetic Act,["] in the vehicle while the vehicle is
- 14 in operation on any highway in this Commonwealth. It is unlawful
- 15 for any person who is a passenger in any vehicle to have any
- 16 opened alcoholic beverage in the vehicle while the vehicle is in

- 1 operation on any highway in this Commonwealth. THIS SUBSECTION
- 2 SHALL NOT APPLY TO A PASSENGER ON A CHARTER BUS OR VAN BEING
- 3 OPERATED BY A CARRIER SUBJECT TO REGULATION BY THE PENNSYLVANIA
- 4 PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION OR THE INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION.
- 5 (b) Penalty.--A person who violates any provision of this
- 6 section is guilty of a summary offense.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
