AN ACT

1 Requiring credit bureaus to delete certain records of delinquent
2 accounts.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Definitions.

6 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
7 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
8 context clearly indicates otherwise:

9 "Credit bureau." Any person, firm or corporation engaged in
10 the business of collecting, maintaining and disseminating credit
11 history information on individual consumers.

12 Section 2. Deletion of certain records.

13 A credit bureau shall delete information relating to a
14 delinquent account not later than six months following payment
15 of the account by debtor in full.

16 Section 3. Effective date.

17 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
