## AN ACT

- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, requiring that motor vehicle insurance premiums be
- 3 paid in advance.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows: 5
- 6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- § 1793.1. Payment of premiums in advance. 8
- 9 (a) General rule. -- An insurer shall not issue or renew a
- motor vehicle liability insurance policy unless the premium is 10
- 11 paid at least three months in advance.
- 12 (b) Obligation of insurer. -- An insurer which issues a motor
- 13 vehicle liability insurance policy for which the premium was not
- 14 paid at least three months in advance shall remain obligated to
- continue the coverage for at least the three-month period even 15
- if the insured fails to pay the remainder of the required 16
- 17 premium.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
