AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, requiring that motor vehicle insurance premiums be
3 paid in advance.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 1793.1. Payment of premiums in advance.

9 (a) General rule.--An insurer shall not issue or renew a
10 motor vehicle liability insurance policy unless the premium is
11 paid at least three months in advance.

12 (b) Obligation of insurer.--An insurer which issues a motor
13 vehicle liability insurance policy for which the premium was not
14 paid at least three months in advance shall remain obligated to
15 continue the coverage for at least the three-month period even
16 if the insured fails to pay the remainder of the required
17 premium.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
