AN ACT

Τ.	Amending the act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), entitled

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17	Section 1. The act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), known
18	as the Public Employe Relations Act, is amended by adding a

20	Section 402. Whenever any member of a designated bargaining
21	unit aboard not to begome a member of the employe exception
<u>4</u>	unit chooses not to become a member of the employe organization
