AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, further providing for notice of department action.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 1551 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 7 § 1551. Notice of department action.
- 8 The department shall promptly [notify] mail a notice to each
- 9 person whose license or permit is suspended as a result of the
- 10 accumulation of points under section 1539 (relating to
- 11 <u>suspension of operating privilege on accumulation of points</u>).
- 12 The [notification that the license or permit is suspended shall
- 13 be made] notice shall be mailed to the address of record within
- 14 six months following the conviction of a violation of this title
- 15 that resulted in the addition of sufficient points to cause the
- 16 suspension. Failure of the department to [give prompt] mail a
- 17 notice of suspension as required by this section shall prohibit

- the department from suspending the license or permit of such 1
- 2 person. This section shall not apply to points assigned to a
- 3 person's record after assignment of points which form the basis
- 4 of an appeal under section 1550 (relating to judicial review)
- 5 until the appeal shall be finally determined, and for six months
- thereafter, or to a suspension ordered as a result of 6
- 7 recalculation of a person's point record as a result of a court
- 8 order.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
