AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, requiring that certain trucks, trailers, truck  
3 tractors and buses be equipped with anti-spray brushes or  
4 skirts.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 4533 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania  
8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

9 § 4533. Rear wheel shields.

10 (a) General rule.--Every truck, trailer and truck tractor  
11 (without a semitrailer) driven on a highway shall be so  
12 constructed or equipped as to bar water or other road surface  
13 substances thrown from the rear wheels of such vehicle or  
14 combination at tangents exceeding 22 1/2 degrees, measured from  
15 the road surface, from passing in a straight line to the rear of  
16 such vehicle or combination.

17 (b) Additional equipment.--Trucks and truck tractors of  
18 classes 3 through 25, semitrailers and buses shall also be

1 equipped with anti-spray brushes or skirts which comply with  
2 regulations established by the department, designed to bar water  
3 or other road surface substances from passing to the sides of  
4 such vehicle or combination.

5       Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
