1 2 3	Amending Title 24 (Education) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for creditable nonschool service for certain merchant seamen.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 8304(b) of Title 24 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 8304. Creditable nonschool service.
9	* * *
10	(b) Limitations on nonschool serviceCreditable nonschool
11	service credit shall be limited to:
12	(1) Intervening military service.
13	(2) Other military service not exceeding five years.
14	(3) Service in any public school or public educational
15	institution in any state other than this Commonwealth or in
16	any territory or area under the jurisdiction of the United
17	States.
18	(4) Service as an administrator, teacher, or instructor

in the field of public school education for any agency or
department of the government of the United States whether or
not such area was under the jurisdiction of the United
States.

5 (5) Previous service as an employee of a county board of 6 school directors which employment was terminated because of 7 the transfer of the administration of such service or of the 8 entire agency to a governmental entity.

9 (6) Previous service as a county employee as a nurse. 10 For every three years or major fraction thereof in previous 11 work experience, an individual may buy one year of creditable 12 service, not to exceed a total of five years. The purchase of 13 this service shall begin within three years of the employee's 14 eligibility to purchase this creditable service.

15 (7) Previous service as a merchant seaman who served in active oceangoing service from December 7, 1941, to August 17 15, 1945, and received a discharge certificate issued by the armed forces of the United States.
