AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
5 laws relating thereto," providing for instruction on hazards
6 of radon and the need for home testing and corrective
7 measures.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
12 section to read:

13 Section 1518.1. Instruction on Hazards of Radon; the Need
14 for Home Testing and Corrective Measures.--In every elementary
15 and middle or junior high school established and maintained in
16 this Commonwealth, instruction shall be provided on the hazards
17 of radon and the importance of home testing. The instruction
18 shall also include the types of corrective measures needed to
19 eliminate the hazards of radon from homes. Each school district

1 shall determine how the instruction will be integrated into the
2 curriculum of each elementary and middle or junior high school.
3 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
