## A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 Expressing the will of the General Assembly relating to the 2 operation of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board. 3 WHEREAS, Political events and court decisions of the previous 4 three months placed the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board in the position of winding down its operations and its very existence; 5 6 and 7 WHEREAS, The morale of board employees and the day-to-day activities of the board are seriously eroded by this legal 8 9 status of suspended activity; and 10 WHEREAS, It is the firm desire of the General Assembly that 11 the board continue its activity relating to the wholesale and retail purchase, sale and distribution of liquor and malt and 12 13 brewed beverages; therefore be it 14 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), that the General Assembly express its resolve that it will take all actions necessary 15 16 before July 1, 1987, to ensure the continuation of the 17 activities of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board relating to

1 the wholesale and retail purchase, sale and distribution of 2 liquor and malt and brewed beverages until the next review 3 period mandated by the act of December 22, 1981 (P.L.508, 4 No.142), known as the Sunset Act; and be it further

5 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to 6 the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board and be publicly read to 7 all of the board's employees.
