A RESOLUTION

1 Providing for a select committee to investigate Pennsylvania's
2 penal system.

3 WHEREAS, Certain questions have arisen relating to the
4 operation of Pennsylvania's penal system; therefore be it

5 RESOLVED, That the Speaker of the House of Representatives
6 appoint a select committee of five members, three from the
7 majority party and two from the minority party, to investigate
8 the operation of Pennsylvania's penal system; and be it further

9 RESOLVED, That the committee may hold hearings, take
10 testimony and make its investigations at such places as it deems
11 necessary in this Commonwealth. Each member of the committee
12 shall have power to administer oaths and affirmations to
13 witnesses appearing before the committee; and be it further

14 RESOLVED, That the committee shall report to the House of
15 Representatives on its activities, findings and recommendations
16 as soon as possible, and shall issue interim reports to the
17 House of Representatives as the committee deems necessary.
