A RESOLUTION

- 1 Directing the House Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs
- 2 to investigate the possibility of placing a veterans' home at
- 3 the Torrance State Hospital.
- 4 WHEREAS, The Torrance State Hospital, a beautiful facility
- 5 located in northeastern Westmoreland County, has existed under
- 6 the Department of Public Welfare for several years; and
- WHEREAS, There are several vacant buildings at the hospital
- 8 at present time, and the number of clients has declined over the
- 9 past several years; and
- 10 WHEREAS, It may be desirable to locate a new veterans' home
- 11 utilizing the vacant buildings at the hospital; and
- 12 WHEREAS, It appears that there is a need for a veterans' home
- 13 in southwestern Pennsylvania; therefore be it
- 14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives direct the House
- 15 Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs to investigate the
- 16 possibility of placing a veterans' home at the Torrance State
- 17 Hospital; and be it further
- 18 RESOLVED, That the committee may hold hearings, take

- 1 testimony and make its investigations at such places as it deems
- 2 necessary in this Commonwealth. Each member of the committee
- 3 shall have power to administer oaths and affirmations to
- 4 witnesses appearing before the committee; and be it further
- 5 RESOLVED, That the committee shall report to the House of
- 6 Representatives on its activities, findings and recommendations
- 7 in 90 days.
