A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring Robert Gordon, Michael McDevitt, William Hunsberger,
2 Stephanie Sloan and Susan Collet for being selected to the
3 first-ever United States team to compete at the Paralympics
4 in Seoul, South Korea.

5 WHEREAS, The 8th Paralympics will be held in Seoul, South
6 Korea, from October 15 through 24, 1988; and

7 WHEREAS, The Paralympics are athletic contests for disabled
8 persons based on the Olympic games; and

9 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania has five individuals who are slated to
10 attend the 8th Paralympics and be part of the first-ever United
11 States team to participate at a Paralympics; and

12 WHEREAS, Robert Gordon of Shippensburg, Michael McDevitt of
13 Drexel Hill, William Hunsberger of Sharon Hill, Stephanie Sloan
14 of Pittsburgh and Susan Collet of Pittsburgh are slated to
15 participate in the 8th Paralympics; and

16 WHEREAS, In order to participate, in addition to excelling in
17 an athletic event or events, each contestant must raise funds
18 from their communities sufficient to pay for their

1 transportation and lodging for the Paralympics; therefore be it

2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor Robert
3 Gordon, Michael McDevitt, William Hunsberger, Stephanie Sloan
4 and Susan Collet for their participation as members of the
5 first-ever United States Paralympics team and wish them every
6 success during the 8th Paralympics; and be it further
