## AN ACT

7	hereby enacts as follows:
8	Section 1. Section 612 of the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103,
9	No.69), known as The Second Class Township Code, reenacted and
10	amended July 10, 1947 (P.L.1481, No.567) and amended April 18,
11	1985 (P.L.11, No.5), is amended to read:
12	Section 612. Expenses and MileageThe expenses allowed the
13	delegates attending the annual meeting may be [in an amount not
14	exceeding ninety dollars per day] the actual expenses incurred
15	for lodging plus twenty-five dollars for meals, gratuities and
16	other expenses for each delegate for <u>EACH OF</u> not more than four
17	days including the time employed in traveling thereto and
18	therefrom, together with mileage going to and returning from
19	such meeting. In addition, the registration or similar fee

- 1 <u>incurred in connection with attending the annual meeting shall</u>
- 2 <u>be an allowable expense.</u>
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
