## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8	Amending the act of February 2, 1966 (1965 P.L.1860, No.586), entitled "An act encouraging landowners to make land and water areas available to the public for recreational purposes by limiting liability in connection therewith, and repealing certain acts," further providing for immunity relating to sports, playground, and certain pleasure-driving use of property, and for the immunity of the Commonwealth and its political subdivisions.
9	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
10	hereby enacts as follows:
11	Section 1. Section 2 of the act of February 2, 1966 (1965
12	P.L.1860, No.586), entitled "An act encouraging landowners to
13	make land and water areas available to the public for
14	recreational purposes by limiting liability in connection
15	therewith, and repealing certain acts," is amended to read:
16	Section 2. As used in this act:
17	(1) "Land" means land, roads, water, watercourses, private
18	ways and buildings, structures and machinery or equipment when
19	attached to the realty.
20	(2) "Owner" means the possessor of a fee interest, a tenant,

lessee, occupant or person in control of the premises. <u>The term</u>
<u>includes the Commonwealth and its political subdivisions.</u>

3 (3) "Recreational purpose" includes, but is not limited to, 4 any of the following, or any combination thereof: hunting, fishing, swimming, boating, camping, picnicking, hiking, 5 pleasure driving (including, but not limited to, driving all-6 terrain vehicles, snowmobiles, motorcycles and similar 7 vehicles), nature study, sports activity, playground activity, 8 water skiing, water sports and viewing or enjoying historical, 9 archaeological, scenic, or scientific sites. 10 (4) "Charge" means the admission price or fee asked in 11

12 return for invitation or permission to enter or go upon the 13 land.

14 Section 2. The immunity conferred by section 1 shall be in 15 addition to any other immunity granted by statute or court 16 decision.

17 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
