A RESOLUTION

1 Calling upon the Auditor General to audit the Delaware River
2 Port Authority.

3 WHEREAS, Questions have arisen concerning the performance of
4 the Delaware River Port Authority; and

5 WHEREAS, The Auditor General as a member of the authority is
6 in a unique position to develop and carry out an effective
7 audit; therefore be it

8 RESOLVED, That the Senate of Pennsylvania calls upon the
9 Auditor General to conduct a thorough and complete audit of the
10 Delaware River Port Authority; and be it further

11 RESOLVED, That the Auditor General seek the cooperation of
12 the State of New Jersey and all other appropriate State and
13 local agencies in conducting this audit; and be it further

14 RESOLVED, That the Auditor General make a report of his
15 findings and recommendations to the Senate as soon as possible.
