AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
5 laws relating thereto," providing for the offering of courses
6 in labor history.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Section 1605 of the act of March 10, 1949
10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is
11 amended by adding a subsection to read:

12 Section 1605. Courses of Study.--* * *

13 (c) In grades nine through twelve, optional courses in labor
14 history shall be made available. The Secretary of Education
15 shall establish an instructional program to assist school
16 districts in offering such courses.

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
