## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of August 17, 1951 (P.L.1254, No.295), entitled
- 2 "An act fixing the minimum pensions of policemen and firemen
- 3 in certain cities, "further providing for annual
- 4 appropriations to police and firefighters' pension funds.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 2 of the act of August 17, 1951
- 8 (P.L.1254, No.295), entitled "An act fixing the minimum pensions
- 9 of policemen and firemen in certain cities, "reenacted and
- 10 amended September 21, 1959 (P.L.919, No.366), is amended to
- 11 read:
- 12 Section 2. The annual appropriation made by such city,
- 13 whether or not it retains its classification as a city of the
- 14 second class A, shall be sufficient[, when added to the
- 15 contributions made by members during such year, sums received
- 16 from tax distributions, and income from investments, to pay in
- 17 full the retirement allowance payable during such year.] to meet
- 18 the minimum obligation of the municipality with respect to the

- 1 pension plan pursuant to the act of December 18, 1984 (P.L.1005,
- 2 No.205), known as the "Municipal Pension Plan Funding Standard
- 3 and Recovery Act."
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
