AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for restitution for  
3 injuries to person or property.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1106(a) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania  
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 1106. Restitution for injuries to person or property.

9 (a) General rule.--Upon conviction for any crime wherein  
10 property has been stolen, converted or otherwise unlawfully  
11 obtained, or its value substantially decreased as a direct  
12 result of the crime, or wherein the victim suffered personal  
13 injury directly resulting from the crime, the offender may be  
14 sentenced to make restitution in addition to the punishment  
15 prescribed therefor. Additionally, the court may sentence the  
16 offender to make payments to an agency or institution which  
17 provides social services to the victim or to the family of the

1 victim, or to individuals similarly situated.

3 Section 2. This act shall apply to actions that are  
4 commenced after the effective date of this act.

5 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
