AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 5, 1968 (P.L.140, No.78), entitled "An
2 act regulating the writing, cancellation of or refusal to
3 renew policies of automobile insurance; and imposing powers
4 and duties on the Insurance Commissioner therefor,"
5 prohibiting the cancellation or refusal to renew policies by
6 reason of operating privileges of an underage person being
7 suspended for an offense relating to alcoholic beverages.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. Section 3 of the act of the act of June 5, 1968
11 (P.L.140, No.78), entitled "An act regulating the writing,
12 cancellation of or refusal to renew policies of automobile
13 insurance; and imposing powers and duties on the Insurance
14 Commissioner therefor," is amended by adding a subsection to
15 read:

16 Section 3. * * *

17 (i) No insurer shall cancel or refuse to renew a policy of
18 automobile insurance for the reason that the named insured or a
19 person who is a resident in the same household or who

1 customarily operates an automobile insured under the policy has
2 had his operating privilege suspended pursuant to 18 Pa.C.S. §
3 6310.4 (relating to restriction of operating privileges).

4 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
