AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), entitled, as reenacted, "An act relating to alcoholic liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto; regulating and restricting the manufacture, purchase, sale, possession, 6 consumption, importation, transportation, furnishing, holding 7 in bond, holding in storage, traffic in and use of alcoholic liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the 8 9 persons engaged or employed therein; defining the powers and duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; providing 10 for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores, 11 12 for the payment of certain license fees to the respective 13 municipalities and townships, for the abatement of certain nuisances and, in certain cases, for search and seizure 14 15 without warrant; prescribing penalties and forfeitures; 16 providing for local option, and repealing existing laws," 17 repealing provisions relating to the property rights of 18 licenses.

- 20 hereby enacts as follows:
- 21 Section 1. Section 468(d) of the act of April 12, 1951
- 22 (P.L.90, No.21), known as the Liquor Code, reenacted and amended
- 23 June 29, 1987 (P.L.32, No.14), is repealed.
- 24 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
