A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 5 hereby resolves as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 7 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 8 That section 3 of Article II be amended to read:
- 9 § 3. Terms of members.
- 10 Senators shall be elected for the term of [four] <u>six</u> years
- 11 and Representatives for the term of [two] three years. Senators
- 12 shall not be eligible for election to more than two full
- 13 consecutive terms of office. Representatives shall not be
- 14 eligible for election to more than three full consecutive terms
- 15 of office.
- 16 Section 2. The amendment proposed in section 1 shall not
- 17 apply to members of the General Assembly holding office on the

1 effective date of the amendment.
