## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- 2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
- 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- 4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- 5 laws relating thereto, " requiring secondary schools to offer
- 6 American sign language as an elective course of study.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 1605.1. American Sign Language. -- Every secondary
- 13 school established and maintained in this Commonwealth shall
- 14 offer instruction in American sign language to be taught as an
- 15 elective course for credit.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
