AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 18, 1974 (P.L.359, No.120), entitled
2 "An act creating the Municipal Police Officers' Education and
3 Training Commission; providing for the commission's
4 membership, selection, compensation, and removal; providing
5 for the powers and duties of the commission; providing for
6 the appointment and duties of the chairman; providing for the
7 act's applicability to the civil service laws; requiring
8 training by certain political subdivisions and police
9 departments; providing penalties for violation thereof; and
10 making an appropriation," providing for training of police
11 officers hired by first class city housing authorities; and
12 making a repeal.

13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
14 hereby enacts as follows:

15 Section 1. Section 2(6) of the act of June 18, 1974
16 (P.L.359, No.120), referred to as the Municipal Police Education
17 and Training Law, amended December 20, 1984 (P.L.1197, No.227),
18 is amended to read:

19 Section 2. Definitions.--As used in this act:

20 * * *

21 (6) "Political subdivision" means any county, city, borough,
22 incorporated town [or township], township or a first class city

1 housing authority.

2 * * *

3 Section 2. This act shall be applicable to all police
4 officers hired by first class city housing authorities on and
5 after the date one year prior to the effective date of this
6 amendatory act. All police officers hired prior to such date
7 shall be exempt from the requirements of this act. Those police
8 officers to whom this act is applicable who are presently
9 employed by first class city housing authorities on the
10 effective date of this amendatory act shall have one year to
11 comply with its provisions.

12 Section 3. Section 2 of the act of October 5, 1980 (P.L.692,
13 No.141), entitled "An act amending the act of June 18, 1974
14 (P.L.359, No.120), entitled 'An act creating the Municipal
15 Police Officers' Education and Training Commission; providing
16 for the commission's membership, selection, compensation, and
17 removal; providing for the powers and duties of the commission;
18 providing for the appointment and duties of the chairman;
19 providing for the act's applicability to the civil service laws;
20 requiring training by certain political subdivisions and police
21 departments; providing penalties for violation thereof; and
22 making an appropriation,' providing police training for security
23 officers appointed by first class city housing authorities," is
24 hereby repealed.

25 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
