AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further defining total income to exclude Federal or
3 State black lung benefits.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1901(c)(16) of Title 75 of the
7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 1901. Exemption of entities and vehicles from fees.

9 * * *

10 (c) Processing fee in lieu of registration fee.--No
11 registration fee shall be charged for vehicles registered by any
12 of the following but the department shall charge a fee of \$10 to
13 cover the costs of processing for issuing or renewing the
14 registration:

15 * * *

16 (16) Any person who is retired and receiving social

1 security or other pension and whose total income from all
2 sources other than Federal or State black lung benefits does
3 not exceed \$14,999 per year. Unless the retired person is
4 physically or mentally incapable of driving the vehicle, the
5 retired person shall be the principal driver of the vehicle
6 but may from time to time authorize another person to drive
7 the vehicle in his or her stead. The total amount of money
8 which is annually lost due to benefits received by those
9 individuals who are eligible for or are receiving benefits
10 pursuant to the act of March 11, 1971 (P.L.104, No.3), known
11 as the "Senior Citizens Rebate and Assistance Act," by the
12 Department of Transportation by operation of this paragraph
13 based on the difference between the normal registration fee
14 and the processing fee shall be appropriated from the Lottery
15 Fund to the Motor License Fund. The Governor is hereby
16 authorized to annually transfer from the Lottery Fund the
17 necessary amount of money to reimburse the Motor License Fund
18 pursuant to this paragraph. Such money is hereby specifically
19 appropriated to the Motor License Fund to be expended by the
20 Department of Transportation with the approval of the
21 Governor.
