AN ACT

1 Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), entitled "An  
2 act concerning townships of the second class; and amending,  
3 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating  
4 thereto," authorizing taxation for retention and service  
5 award programs for volunteer firefighters, and for training  
6 firefighters for hazardous waste management.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Subsection A of section 905 of the act of May 1,  
10 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), known as The Second Class Township Code,  
11 reenacted and amended July 10, 1947 (P.L.1481, No.567), is  
12 amended by adding clauses to read:

13 Section 905. Township and Special Tax Levies.--A. The board  
14 of township supervisors may, by resolution, levy taxes upon all  
15 real property and upon all occupations, or upon real property  
16 alone, within the township made taxable for township purposes,  
17 as ascertained by the last adjusted valuation for county  
18 purposes, for the purposes and at the rates hereinafter

1 specified. All taxes shall be collected in cash.

3 9. An annual tax, not exceeding one mill, for retention and  
4 service award programs for volunteer firefighters.

5 10. An annual tax, not exceeding one mill, for the purpose  
6 of training firefighters for hazardous waste management.

8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
