12	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania	
13	hereby enacts as follows:	
14	Section 1. Sections THE TITLE AND SECTIONS 6, 7 and 8 of the	<
15	act of April 6, 1980 (P.L.82, No.28), known as the Thaddeus	
16	Stevens State School of Technology Act, are amended to read:

- 4 <u>IN VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL EDUCATION SHALL BE GIVEN.</u>
- 5 Section 6. Board of trustees.
- 6 The board of trustees shall consist of nine members, who
- 7 shall serve without compensation, and be appointed by the
- 8 Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate. Said
- 9 trustees shall be a body politic or corporate, of the name of
- 10 the Thaddeus Stevens State School of Technology. They shall
- 11 [manage and direct the affairs of the institution], <u>under</u>
- 12 <u>section 1311 of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175)</u>,
- 13 known as "The Administrative Code of 1929," have general
- 14 <u>direction and control of the property and management of the</u>
- 15 <u>institution; develop broad institutional policy;</u> and make all
- 16 necessary bylaws and regulations, not inconsistent with either
- 17 the provisions of the Constitution, laws of the Commonwealth, or
- 18 rules and regulations of the State Board of Education. Of the
- 19 trustees first appointed, three shall serve for one year, three
- 20 for two years, and three for three years, and at the expiration
- 21 of the respective periods the vacancies shall be filled by the
- 22 Governor, by appointment, for three years, as hereinbefore
- 23 provided; and should any vacancy occur by death or resignation,
- 24 or otherwise, of any trustee, such vacancy shall be filled, by
- 25 appointment as aforesaid, for the unexpired term of said
- 26 trustee. The Secretary of Education shall be ex-officio member
- 27 of the board of trustees.
- 28 Section 7. President of the school.
- 29 The chief administrator and academic officer of the Thaddeus
- 30 Stevens State School of Technology shall be the president whose

duties shall be defined by the board of trustees and approved by the Secretary of Education. [Other administrative personnel 2 3 shall be designated at the discretion of the board of trustees.] 4 Section 8. [Individuals eligible for admission] ADMISSION OF 5 STUDENTS AND EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM. 6 [There shall be received into the institution indigent 7 orphan persons or other deserving persons, from the State of Pennsylvania, above the age of 15 years, whose admission may be 8 applied for under such regulations as the board of trustees may 10 adopt.] THE SCHOOL SHALL PROVIDE A PROGRAM OF EDUCATION <----11 HEREINAFTER DEFINED FOR THOSE PERSONS ADMITTED TO THE <u>INSTITUTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 4.</u> In considering such admission 12 13 no preference shall be shown on account of race, color, sex, 14 marital status, ethnic group or religion. 15 The course of instruction shall be the equivalent level 16 of [the junior and senior year of a four year public vocationaltechnical high school and/or a two year] a two-year 17 18 postsecondary institution which shall include[: 19 (1) [vocational] vocational-technical education of no 20 more than two years leading to the awarding of [diplomas,] 21 certificates or associate degrees, when approved by the 22 Secretary of Education in accordance with rules and 23 regulations established by the State Board for this level of 24 education, for the purpose of fitting pupils to pursue 25 effectively a recognized profitable employment[; and 26 (2) evening or other classes providing such instruction 27 for persons who have left full-time school providing the 28 board of trustees shall establish and charge tuition for such instruction that will cover the total cost of instruction 29

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including all direct costs and the allocable portion of all

- 2 Section 2. Section 10 of the act is repealed.
- 3 Section 3. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 4 <u>Section 10.1.</u> Rights of faculty and staff.
- 5 <u>(a) Existing faculty.</u> Except as otherwise provided by law, <—
- 6 faculty employed in the Thaddeus Stevens State School of
- 7 Technology on the effective date of this section shall enjoy the <--
- 8 same privileges, including tenure rights, and be subject to the
- 9 <u>same laws</u>, <u>EXCEPT CERTIFICATION</u>, <u>as faculty in the public</u> <--

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- 10 schools of this Commonwealth and to collective bargaining
- 11 agreements entered into under the act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563,
- 12 No.195), known as the "Public Employe Relations Act."
- 13 <u>(b) Subsequently hired faculty. Faculty hired by the</u>
- 14 <u>Thaddeus Stevens State School of Technology after the effective</u>
- 15 <u>date of this section shall be subject to collective bargaining</u>
- 16 agreements entered into under the "Public Employe Relations
- 17 Act."
- 18 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
