AN ACT

- 1 Prescribing the duties and liabilities of roller skating center
- 2 operators and persons who utilize roller skating centers; and
- 3 providing for the acceptance of certain risks by persons who
- 4 utilize roller skating centers.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Short title.
- 8 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Roller
- 9 Skating Safety Act of 1990.
- 10 Section 2. Definitions.
- 11 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 12 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 13 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Operator." A person or entity who owns or controls or who
- 15 has operational responsibility for a roller skating center.
- 16 "Roller skater." A person wearing roller skates while that
- 17 person is in a roller skating center for the purpose of roller
- 18 skating.

- 1 "Roller skating center." A building, facility or other
- 2 premises which provides an area specifically designed to be used
- 3 for roller skating by the public.
- 4 "Spectator." A person who is present in a roller skating
- 5 center only for the purpose of observing skating activity,
- 6 whether recreational or competitive.
- 7 Section 3. Duties of roller skating center operator.
- 8 Each roller skating center operator shall do all of the
- 9 following:
- 10 (1) Post the duties of roller skaters and spectators as
- 11 prescribed in this act in conspicuous places.
- 12 (2) Comply with the safety standards specified in the
- 13 roller skating rink safety standards published by the Roller
- 14 Skating Rink Operators Association, (1980).
- 15 (3) Maintain roller skating equipment and roller skating
- surfaces according to the safety standards cited in paragraph
- 17 (2).
- 18 (4) Maintain the stability and legibility of all
- 19 required signs, symbols and posted notices.
- 20 Section 4. Duties of roller skater.
- 21 While in a roller skating area, each roller skater shall do
- 22 all of the following:
- 23 (1) Maintain reasonable control of his or her speed and
- 24 course at all times.
- 25 (2) Read all posted signs and warnings.
- 26 (3) Maintain a proper lookout to avoid other roller
- 27 skaters and objects.
- 28 (4) Accept the responsibility for knowing the range of
- 29 his or her own ability to negotiate the intended direction of
- 30 travel while on roller skates and to skate within the limits

- 1 of that ability.
- 2 (5) Refrain from acting in a manner which may cause
- 3 injury to others.
- 4 Section 5. Acceptance of danger.
- 5 Each person who participates in roller skating accepts the
- 6 danger that inheres in that activity insofar as the dangers are
- 7 obvious and necessary. Those dangers include, but are not
- 8 limited to, injuries that result from collisions with other
- 9 roller skaters or other spectators, injuries that result from
- 10 falls and injuries which involve objects or artificial
- 11 structures properly within the intended travel of the roller
- 12 skater which are not otherwise attributable to the operator's
- 13 breach of his or her common law duties.
- 14 Section 6. Violations.
- 15 A roller skater, spectator or operator who violates this act
- 16 shall be liable in a civil action for damages for that portion
- 17 of the loss or damage resulting from the violation.
- 18 Section 7. Effective date.
- 19 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
