AN ACT

1 Amending the act of July 12, 1972 (P.L.765, No.181), entitled
2 "An act relating to drugs and alcohol and their abuse,
3 providing for projects and programs and grants to educational
4 agencies, other public or private agencies, institutions or
5 organizations," providing block grant drug funds for
6 institutions of higher education offering drug treatment
7 programs.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. The act of July 12, 1972 (P.L.765, No.181),
11 entitled "An act relating to drugs and alcohol and their abuse,
12 providing for projects and programs and grants to educational
13 agencies, other public or private agencies, institutions or
14 organizations," is amended by adding a section to read:

15 Section 2.1. Drug Treatment Programs at Institutions of
16 Higher Education.--Every institution of higher education
17 offering students a drug treatment program designed and
18 implemented by health personnel and certified drug counselors
19 shall be eligible for Federal block grant drug funds granted to

1 the Commonwealth.

2 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1990.
