AN ACT

Amending the act of July 12, 1972 (P.L.765, No.181), entitled 2 "An act relating to drugs and alcohol and their abuse, 3 providing for projects and programs and grants to educational agencies, other public or private agencies, institutions or 5 organizations," providing block grant drug funds for 6 institutions of higher education offering drug treatment 7 programs. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. The act of July 12, 1972 (P.L.765, No.181), 11 entitled "An act relating to drugs and alcohol and their abuse, providing for projects and programs and grants to educational 12 agencies, other public or private agencies, institutions or 13 14 organizations," is amended by adding a section to read: 15 Section 2.1. Drug Treatment Programs at Institutions of Higher Education. -- Every institution of higher education 16 offering students a drug treatment program designed and 17 18 implemented by health personnel and certified drug counselors shall be eligible for Federal block grant drug funds granted to 19

- 1 the Commonwealth.
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1990.
