AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 13, 1836 (1835 P.L.551, No.169),
2 entitled "An act relating to roads, highways and bridges,"
3 regulating the breadth of roads.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 12 of the act of June 13, 1836 (P.L.551,
7 No.169), referred to as the General Road Law, is amended to
8 read:

9 Section 12. If it shall appear by the report of viewers to
10 the court directing the view, that such road is necessary, the
11 said court shall direct what breadth the road so reported shall
12 be opened, and the proceedings in such cases shall be entered on
13 record, as before directed, and thenceforth such road shall be
14 deemed and taken to be a lawful private road. The breadth of the
15 road shall be in conformity with any local ordinance regulating
16 subdivisions.

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
