A RESOLUTION

Designating the week of April 22 through April 28, 1990, as 1 "Victim Rights Week" in Pennsylvania. 2 3 WHEREAS, All Pennsylvanians, regardless of gender, race, age or economic status, may be victims of sexual violence or 4 5 domestic violence during their lives; and 6 WHEREAS, Victims of sexual violence or domestic violence should have full access to services and programs which provide 7 8 short- and long-term assistance for victimization recovery; and 9 WHEREAS, In 1989, Pennsylvania's rape crisis centers assisted over 24,000 victims of sexual violence; and 10 11 WHEREAS, Last year, over 70,000 victims of domestic violence were aided by Pennsylvania domestic violence service providers; 12 13 and

1 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Coalition Against Rape and the 2 Pennsylvania Coalition Against Domestic Violence and their 3 service providers have played a vital role in the Commonwealth's 4 commitment to providing services to and protecting the rights of 5 victims of sexual violence and of domestic violence; therefore 6 be it

Resolved, That the House of Representatives hereby designate
the week of April 22 through April 28, 1990, as "Victim Rights
Week" in Pennsylvania.
