A RESOLUTION

Memorializing the Secretary of Commerce to direct the Bureau of the Census to include all active military personnel in the census count by municipality, county and State.

WHEREAS, The official decennial census in mandated by article I, section 2, clause 3 of the Constitution of the United States; and

WHEREAS, The members of the armed forces are numerically important to a full and accurate census count of the Nation and its constituent states; and

WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has historically provided a significant number of men and women to serve in the armed forces of the United States; and

WHEREAS, These service men and women are full citizens of this Commonwealth and are entitled to vote for the candidates of their choice at the local, state and national level; and

WHEREAS, A full and accurate census count will afford this Commonwealth its fair apportionment of seats in the House of Representatives in the Congress of the United States; and

WHEREAS, The incorporated cities, boroughs, townships and towns of this Commonwealth have given many of their sons and daughters to serve the Nation and its armed forces; and

WHEREAS, A full and accurate census count will help provide the municipalities and counties of this Commonwealth with their fair share of Federal and State funds returning as grant-in-aid programs; therefore be it RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives memorialize the United States Secretary of Commerce to direct the Census Bureau of the Federal Department of Commerce to include all active military personnel in the 1990 census count by municipality, county and state.
