A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating May 1 through May 7, 1990, as "Barrier Awareness
- Week in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Four out of five Americans will experience some form
- 4 of disability during their lifetime, and there are currently 37
- 5 million Americans who are disabled; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The financial and physical barriers can be overcome,
- 7 but, emotionally and culturally, individuals with disabilities
- 8 are blocked as surely and permanently as indifference will
- 9 permit; and
- 10 WHEREAS, There are no cures for many disabilities; and
- 11 WHEREAS, No one can really understand the full implication of
- 12 living with a disability unless he or she has experienced that
- 13 disability personally; and
- 14 WHEREAS, There has not been developed a pill to dull the

- 1 hurts and injustices inflicted upon individuals with
- 2 disabilities due to a lack of understanding; and
- 3 WHEREAS, There has not been a vaccine discovered that can
- 4 eradicate the widespread problems of underemployment and lack of
- 5 employment for individuals with disabilities; therefore be it
- 6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 7 week of May 1 through May 7, 1990, as "Barrier Awareness Week"
- 8 in Pennsylvania.
