AN ACT

- Thomas L. Gibson, as the State song of the Commonwealth of

- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Official State song.
- 7 The song "Pennsylvania State Song," lyrics and music by
- 8 Thomas L. Gibson, is hereby adopted as the State song of
- 9 Pennsylvania and shall be the official song for all public
- 10 purposes. The lyrics of the song are as follows:
