AN ACT

- Designating the Province of Taiwan, Republic of China, as a
 "sister state."
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Purpose.
- 6 The General Assembly finds it would be beneficial to both
- 7 Pennsylvania and the Province of Taiwan, Republic of China, to
- 8 recognize the cultural and commercial links each possesses and
- 9 work to improve them and to create a "sister state"
- 10 relationship.
- 11 Section 2. Designation.
- 12 The Province of Taiwan, Republic of China, is designated as a
- 13 "sister state" to Pennsylvania.
- 14 Section 3. Duties of department.
- 15 The Department of Commerce shall perform all necessary
- 16 requirements to secure and maintain the "sister state"

- 1 designation as provided for in section 2.
- 2 Section 4. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect in 60 days. 3
