9	§ 6122. Authority to erect traffic-control devices.

11	(e) CostsThe cost of traffic-control signals located on
12	Pennsylvania intersections shall be borne jointly by the
13	municipality and the Commonwealth. As used in this subsection,
14	the term "cost of traffic-control signal" means the purchase
15	price of a traffic-control signal, the cost of erecting the
16	traffic-control signal and the cost of maintaining the traffic-
17	<u>control signal.</u>
18	(f) Powers and duties of Pennsylvania Public Utility

Commission. -- Nothing contained in this section shall impair, 1 2 <u>suspend</u>, <u>contract</u>, <u>enlarge</u>, <u>extend</u> <u>or</u> <u>affect</u> <u>in</u> <u>any</u> <u>manner</u> <u>the</u> 3 powers and duties of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission 4 as contained in 66 Pa.C.S. §§ 2702 (relating to construction, relocation, suspension and abolition of crossings), 2703 5 (relating to ejectment in crossing cases) and 2704 (relating to 6 compensation for damages occasioned by construction, relocation 7 or abolition of crossings). 8 9 Section 2. This act shall apply to the maintenance costs of traffic-control devices which are in existence on the effective 10 date of this act. 11

12 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
