AN ACT

Amending the act of April 29, 1937 (P.L.487, No.115), entitled, 2 as reenacted and amended, "An act to provide for the 3 permanent personal registration of electors in cities of the second class, cities of the second class A, cities of the 5 third class, boroughs, towns, and townships as a condition of their right to vote at elections and primaries, and their 7 enrollment as members of political parties as a further condition of their right to vote at primaries; prescribing 8 certain procedure for the conduct of elections and primaries 9 and the challenge and proof of qualifications of electors; 10 requiring the county commissioners of the various counties to 11 12 act as a registration commission therefor; and prescribing 13 the powers and duties of citizens, parties, political bodies, registration commissions, commissioners, registrars, 14 15 inspectors of registration and other appointees of 16 registration commissions, county election boards, election 17 officers, municipal officers, departments and bureaus, police 18 officers, courts, judges, prothonotaries, sheriffs, county commissioners, peace officers, county treasurers, county 19 20 controllers, registrars of vital statistics, certain public 21 utility corporations, real estate brokers, rental agents, and 22 boards of school directors; and imposing penalties, "FURTHER PROVIDING FOR MANNER OF REGISTRATION; AND providing for voter 23 24 registration in conjunction with motor vehicle driver's

- 22 MILITARY SERVICE, PERSONS IN THE MERCHANT MARINE, PERSONS IN
- 23 RELIGIOUS AND WELFARE GROUPS OFFICIALLY ATTACHED TO AND SERVING
- 24 WITH THE ARMED FORCES AND CIVILIAN FEDERAL PERSONNEL OVERSEAS

- 13 INFORMATION: (1) THE SURNAME OF THE APPLICANT, (2) HIS CHRISTIAN
- 14 NAME OR NAMES, (4) THE STREET OR ROAD AND NUMBER, IF ANY, OF HIS
- 15 HOME RESIDENCE AND THE DATE OF LEAVING SAME, PROVIDING THAT, IN
- 16 THE EVENT THERE IS NO STREET ADDRESS, THE REGISTRANT MUST LIST
- 17 THE NEAREST CROSS STREET OR ROAD, (5) IF HIS RESIDENCE WAS A
- 18 PORTION ONLY OF A HOUSE, THE LOCATION OR NUMBER OF THE ROOM OR
- 19 ROOMS, APARTMENT, FLAT OR FLOOR WHICH HE OCCUPIED, (6) THE DATE
- 20 HIS RESIDENCE BEGAN AT THE PLACE WHICH IS HIS HOME RESIDENCE,
- 21 (7) HIS HOME RESIDENCE ADDRESS WHEN HE LAST REGISTERED AND THE

- 1 LABELS, (14) WHETHER HE HAS A PHYSICAL DISABILITY WHICH WILL
- 2 RENDER HIM UNABLE TO SEE OR MARK THE BALLOT OR OPERATE THE
- 3 VOTING MACHINE OR TO ENTER THE VOTING COMPARTMENT OR VOTING
- 4 MACHINE BOOTH WITHOUT ASSISTANCE, AND, IF SO, HIS DECLARATION OF
- 5 THAT FACT AND HIS STATEMENT OF THE EXACT NATURE OF SUCH
- 6 DISABILITY, (15) THE DESIGNATION OF THE POLITICAL PARTY OF THE
- 7 ELECTOR FOR THE PURPOSE OF VOTING AT PRIMARIES, (16) THE
- 8 DECLARATION OF REGISTRATION, AS HEREINAFTER PRESCRIBED, WHICH
- 9 SHALL BE SIGNED BY THE ELECTOR, (17) THE HEIGHT OF THE APPLICANT
- 10 IN FEET AND INCHES, (18) THE COLOR OF HIS HAIR, (19) THE COLOR
- 11 OF HIS EYES, (20) THE DATE OF HIS BIRTH, (21) THE DESIGNATION BY
- 12 THE ELECTOR THAT THE OFFICIAL REGISTRATION APPLICATION CARD IS

- 17 EACH OFFICIAL REGISTRATION APPLICATION CARD FOR REGISTRATION BY
- 18 PERSONS REGISTERING UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL ALSO HAVE (22) A
- 19 SUFFICIENT NUMBER OF SPACES THEREON FOR THE INSERTION BY THE
- 20 COMMISSION, BUT NOT BY THE APPLICANT, OF THE CITY OF THE SECOND
- 21 CLASS, CITY OF THE SECOND CLASS A, CITY OF THE THIRD CLASS,
- 22 BOROUGH, TOWN, TOWNSHIP, WARD AND ELECTION DISTRICT, IF ANY, IN

- 30 AFTER REGISTRATION, THE NUMBER AND LETTER, IF ANY, OF THE STUB

- 1 OF THE BALLOT ISSUED TO HIM, OR HIS NUMBER IN THE ORDER OF
- 2 ADMISSION TO THE VOTING MACHINES, AND (24) THE SIGNATURE OR
- 3 INITIALS OF THE ELECTION OFFICER, COMMISSIONER, REGISTER OR
- 4 CLERK, WHO ENTERS THE RECORD OF VOTING ON THE CARD. IMMEDIATELY
- 5 FOLLOWING THE SPACES FOR INSERTING THE INFORMATION AS PROVIDED
- 6 IN THIS SUBSECTION, THE APPLICANT SHALL AFFIX HIS SIGNATURE

- 9 SECTION 2. THE ACT IS AMENDED BY ADDING A SECTION TO READ:
- 10 Section 19.1. Motor Vehicle Driver's License Voter
- 11 Registration Application. -- (a) (1) In addition to any other
- 12 method provided under law, each application for a driver's
- 13 <u>license</u>, as defined in 75 Pa.C.S. § 102 (relating to
- 14 <u>definitions</u>), any renewal application and any identification
- 15 card application issued under 75 Pa.C.S. § 1510(b) (relating to
- 16 <u>issuance and content of driver's license</u>), shall serve as an
- 17 <u>application to register to vote.</u>
- 18 (2) An application for voter registration submitted to the
- 19 Department of Transportation under this section shall be
- 20 <u>considered as updating any previous voter registration</u>
- 21 <u>information by the applicant.</u>
- 22 (3) Each driver's license application shall include a box or <-
- 23 other device to permit an applicant to decline to register to
- 24 <u>vote. Use of this information for any other purpose is</u>
- 25 prohibited.
- 26 (b) (1) The Department of Transportation shall include a
- 27 voter registration application form as part of an application
- 28 for a driver's license. SUCH VOTER REGISTRATION FORMS SHALL
- 29 <u>INCLUDE INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO REGISTER TO VOTE.</u>
- 30 (2) The content FORMAT of the driver's license/voter

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- 1 registration application shall be determined and prescribed by
- 2 the Secretary of the Commonwealth and the Secretary of
- 3 Transportation. THE APPLICATION SHALL CONTAIN ALL INFORMATION

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- 4 REQUIRED IN SECTION 18(C)(1).
- 5 (3) The voter registration application portion of an
- 6 application for a State motor vehicle driver's license: (i) may
- 7 not require any information which duplicates information
- 8 required in the driver's license portion of the form, other than
- 9 <u>a second signature or other information as necessary; (ii) shall</u>
- 10 include a means by which an applicant may decline to register to
- 11 vote; (iii) may require only the minimum amount of information
- 12 <u>necessary to prevent duplicate voter registration, to enable the</u>
- 13 commission to assess the eligibility of the applicant and to
- 14 administer voter registration and other parts of the election
- 15 process; (iv) shall include a declaration of eligibility; (v)
- 16 shall require the signature of the applicant, under penalty of
- 17 perjury; and (vi) shall be made available to the appropriate
- 18 registration commission.
- 19 (c) Any change of address form submitted in accordance with
- 20 State law for purposes of State motor vehicle driver's license
- 21 <u>shall serve as notification of change of address for voter</u>
- 22 registration with respect to elections for State office for the
- 23 applicant involved if the applicant states on the form that the
- 24 change of address is for voter registration purposes as well as
- 25 for purposes of the license to operate a motor vehicle.
- 26 (d) (1) The Department of Transportation shall forward the
- 27 completed voter registration information to the Department of
- 28 State or the appropriate commission.
- 29 (2) Upon receipt of the completed voter registration
- 30 <u>information from the Department of Transportation or the</u>

- 1 Department of State, the commission shall make an entry of the
- 2 <u>date received on each application and process the application.</u>
- 3 No applicant shall be deemed eligible to vote until the
- 4 <u>commission has received and processed the application.</u>
- 5 (e) The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall have the primary
- 6 responsibility for implementing and enforcing the driver's
- 7 license voter registration system created under this section.
- 8 The Secretary of the Commonwealth, in consultation with the
- 9 <u>Secretary of Transportation, may promulgate rules and</u>
- 10 regulations for implementing and enforcing this section.
- 11 (f) A person who is not a qualified elector and who has
- 12 applied for a driver's license under 75 Pa.C.S. § 1503(c)
- 13 (relating to persons ineligible for licensing) is ineligible to
- 14 register to vote under this section.
- 15 (q) The Department of State shall reimburse the Department
- 16 of Transportation for costs incurred in operating the voter
- 17 registration program, as determined in a memorandum of
- 18 understanding between the departments.
- 19 (H) FAILURE TO PROPERLY COMPLETE A VOTER REGISTRATION
- 20 APPLICATION FORM SHALL NOT IN ANY WAY AFFECT THE VALIDITY OF AN
- 21 APPLICATION FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE, A RENEWAL APPLICATION OR AN
- 22 IDENTIFICATION CARD APPLICATION.
- 23 (I) FAILURE TO PROPERLY COMPLETE AN APPLICATION FOR A
- 24 DRIVER'S LICENSE, A RENEWAL APPLICATION OR AN IDENTIFICATION
- 25 CARD APPLICATION FORM SHALL NOT IN ANY WAY AFFECT THE VALIDITY
- 26 OF A VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATION.
- 27 Section $\frac{2}{3}$. Nothing in this act shall preclude the
- 28 Secretary of the Commonwealth from implementing the driver's
- 29 license voter registration program, established under this act,
- 30 before January 1, 1993. If Federal legislation passes relating

- 1 to this act, this act shall be implemented in compliance with
- 2 the Federal legislation.
- 3 Section 3 4. This act shall take effect January 1, 1993. <--
